Ascension of our Lord Elementary/Junior High School	planted 2002; butterfly garden, boulder seating area
Bishop Carroll Senior High School	large area next to playing field
Bishop Pinkham	planted native trees and shrubs 2006
Cardinal Newman Elementary/Junior High	planning ongoing for several years; first phase started 2006
Ecole Holy Names	Interested in concept
Monsignor E.L. Doyle Elementary School	project installed 2002; large mulched area with native plantings; low boulder seating
St. Boniface Elementary School	project installed 2002; benches, boulders, native plants
St. James Elementary/Junior High School	boulder seating embedded in asphalt; good collection of native plant species
St. Luke Elementary School (Ecole)	planted 2002; small area of exterior courtyard; small raised beds, embedded boulder seating; great plant diversity including shrubs, vines, grasses and wildflowers
St. Margaret Elementary/Junior High School	area fenced, good plantings but has been neglected in recent years
St. Pius X Elementary School (Ecole)	free-standing amphitheatre, large mulched area with native plants; poured concrete edging; front of school has elaborate vegetable/flower garden
St. William Elementary School	installed 2002; great use of swaths of prairie grasses; boulder seating; bands of native shrubs; used deep wood mulch to smother existing grass
